designation, changing this to a simple majority; and; eliminates the need for the Governor in Council to approve this vote, changing this to approval by the Band Council and the Minister.

Amends the definition of Aboriginal Fishery introduced in Bill C-38 to: "means that fish is harvested by an Aboriginal organization or any of its members for the purpose of using the fish as food, for social or ceremonial purposes or for purposes set out in a land claims agreement entered into with the Aboriginal organization."

Includes technical changes to the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012 that was introduced in Bill C-38.

Amends the Navigable Waters Protection Act (now the "Navigation Protection Act") and the Canada Labour Code.

Receives Royal Assent on December 14, 2012
