Roger D. Jones is a council member of the Sagamok Anishnawbek, Robinson-Huron Treaty Territory and was the founding president of the Indigenous Bar Association, served on the Board, and the former Vice-Chair, Native Law section of the Canadian Bar Association. Roger Jones is the Assembly of First Nations lead representative at the Indigenous languages legislation co-development table.

Roger Jones will present an update on the Indigenous Languages Act, clarifying how the Technical Discussion Paper submitted to the Department of Canadian Heritage meets the Joint Principles put forth as the foundation for the legislation. He will then describe the Joint Implementation Plan which will provide the immediate actions to be completed by the Co-development Table to ensure the proper implementation of the legislation.
