The forum is designed to provide delegates the opportunity to provide their input on the implementation of the First Nations National Housing and related Infrastructure Strategy which is guided solely by the aim of ensuring that all First Nations members living in or away from their First Nations will have access to housing that suits their needs.

The forum will host plenary sessions and interactive workshops on the long-term approach for First Nations Housing and related Infrastructure for First Nations and for First Nations members who live in urban, rural, and northern areas. We will also focus on the operations and maintenance (O&M) with an emphasis on adopting an Asset Management Planning (AMP) approach. The forum will provide space for First Nations to share successes in instituting AMP as a new way of tracking O&M.

As part of the Forum, we are hosting a tradeshow showcasing housing innovation, asset management processes and infrastructure services. Registration for the Tradeshow is now open.
